



Policy on Transfer Students to the PBA PharmD Program

The School does not accept transfer students directly into the professional program from other schools/colleges of pharmacy. The only process by which a pharmacy student enrolled in another program can be considered for admission is to apply as a new student in the current admissions cycle to be a part of the current incoming class, with the understanding that no transfer credit or credit waiver can be granted for previously completed professional coursework. It is strongly encouraged for the applicant to request a letter from the dean of the previous program stating that the student remained in good standing at that school both professionally and academically. This letter would be included with the other required documentation for application, all applicants will need to submit a PharmCAS application. The deadline to apply can be found at PharmCAS.org.
