Tribute to Dr. Donald Warren

Dr. Donald Warren, a pillar in the greater Palm Beach community, died Monday, March 31, 2014. His life centered on his deep faith in Christ, unconditional love for his family and dedicated service to others.

Dr. Warren and his wife, Bebe, were honored by the Town of Palm Beach's Centennial Commission as Centennial Ambassadors, a title awarded to residents with a long-standing connection to the island. They are admired and respected for their commitment to a wide array of philanthropic endeavors, their volunteer positions and their integral role in founding and developing Palm Beach Atlantic University.

Having established a stellar cardiology practice, Dr. Warren frequently made house calls to island residents who suffered heart ailments. He was instrumental in procuring a medical van, donated by Town resident Helen Fraser, to enhance immediate medical care for any emergency including cardiac arrest. For more than forty years, Dr. Warren touched the lives of countless patients and their families, setting the standard for superior supervision with his hands-on skilled and compassionate care.

A simple vision begun in 1968 to create a Christian college became a life-long labor of love and his legacy. Today, Palm Beach Atlantic University exemplifies the best in education, service and faith, in preparation of the next generation of government and business leaders, advocates for the arts, guardians of medical excellence and protectors of the disadvantaged.

Therefore, let all of the residents of the Town of Palm Beach share in this tribute to honor Dr. Donald Warren and celebrate his life and abundant gifts to our community.
