Welcome to PBA

In an effort to assist you in finding authorized spaces on the campus, parking is available in clearly posted designated lots for vehicles with a valid PBA permit.

Please be aware of the designated parking areas and those spaces that are reserved for no parking. The Department of Public Safety strictly enforces all parking regulations 24/7. It is your responsibility to be aware of all regulations while utilizing these parking areas.

Please Note: PBA does not enforce Parking regulations on any city roadways. The city of West Palm Beach has jurisdiction of all street parking.

Parking Registration

It is important that drivers are aware that all vehicles (including motorcycles, scooters and bikes) must be registered and display a valid parking decal. Parking decals will be placed on the left (driver's side) rear window or bumper to avoid parking citations.

Parking decal registration is available online at go.pba.edu/Parking. More information about temporary and visitor dash passes can be found at go.pba.edu/visitor. Dash pass should be displayed as soon as possible to minimize risk of citation.

Parking decals are not transferable. If you sell or bring a different vehicle to campus, you will need to change your parking registration to reflect the change. The person who registered the vehicle is responsible for any violations committed by anyone operating the vehicle.

The Department of Public Safety updates and electronically publishes a Parking and Traffic Handbook @ go.pba.edu/Parking (myPBA login required). This Handbook will include up-to-date information on parking regulations and fines associated with violations.

Visitor Parking

Short-term parking for visitors is available throughout the campus as indicated in the map.

Family Church Downtown and Memorial Presbyterian Church

Our neighbor churches provide PBA with additional parking areas. Vehicles must display a valid PBA parking decal to park in these approved areas. However, during special events, neighboring churches may close down parking lots. Please observe and abide by all parking lot signage and postings.

Lost/Stolen Decal

Report any lost or stolen decal as soon as possible to the Department of Public Safety.

Towing/Immobilization and Payment of Fines/Appeals Policy

Vehicles may be cited for failure to follow parking rules and regulations. Vehicles that do not have a valid PBA decal are subject to immobilization (booting), or towing when the vehicle may endanger life or property. Charges and fines are assessed to the student's account. Unpaid charges or fines will result in a hold being placed on the student's account, prohibiting future action (such as course registration). To appeal a citation, please go to go.pba.edu/appeal.

Parking Areas

1. Watson Hall Lot: Resident Parking Only 24/7 (Red Decal).

2. Dixie Garage: Resident Parking Only 24/7 (Red Decal). Motorcycles and Scooters may park in the designated area on the first floor of the garage. Current PBA Decal required for ID card access. No Employee Parking, except Motorcycles and Scooters.

3. Greene Complex Parking Lot: Commuter and Employee Parking Only. (Aqua, Green and White Decals). **No Overnight Parking. No Sunday Parking.**

4. Athletics Parking Lot: Athletics Officials Only 24/7. No Sunday Parking.

5. Intramural Field Parking Lot: Commuter and Employee Parking Only. (Aqua, Green and White Decals). No Overnight Parking. No Sunday Parking.

6. "The Q" Parking Lot: Commuter and Employee Parking Only (Aqua, Green and White Decals). No Overnight Parking. No Sunday Parking.

7. Memorial Presbyterian Church West Lot: Visitor, Commuter, and Employee Parking Only (Aqua, Green and White Decals). No Overnight Parking. No Sunday Parking.

8. Department of Public Safety Parking Lot: Visitors of DPS and Mail Room Only.

9. Memorial Presbyterian Church North Lot: Commuter and Employee Parking Only. (Aqua, Green and White Decals). **No Overnight Parking. No Sunday Parking.**

10. Chadbourne Parking Lot: Commuter and Employee Parking Lot. (Aqua, Green and White Decals). **No Overnight Parking. No Sunday Parking.**

11. Family Church East Lot: Commuter and Employee Parking Only. (Aqua, Green and White Decals). **No Overnight Parking. No Sunday Parking.**

12. Rinker Parking Lot: Reserved Parking 24/7. No Overnight Parking.

13. Coastal Towers Parking Lot: Spaces Reserved for Assigned Parking Only. (Gold Decal)

14. Admissions/Borbe Hall Parking Lot: Residential Parking Only 24/7. No Parking Anytime in Reserved/Assigned spaces. **No Parking Anytime in marked Future Sailfish spaces, M-F, and Sunday after 11pm.**

15. Sachs Hall Parking Lot: Reserved for Visitor Parking Only 24/7.

NOTE: A parking decal does not guarantee a parking space. It grants authorization to park in an available space in designated parking lots.

PBA parking in blacked-out lots is strictly prohibited.

Overnight Parking prohibited unless otherwise noted.

The City of West Palm Beach has jurisdiction of city roadways and enforces on-street Parking near PBA. Please observe and abide by all street signage for payment instructions and regulations, which are enforced 24/7.
